Please note that unlike previous years we have not been able to book a coach for adult volunteers to accompany us. However, you are more than welcome to drive up and meet us there – it is always a fabulous day out and one that is enjoyed by children and adults alike. Class & Date	Years 2 – 6 Wednesday 28th September
Time/Duration	Leaving School at 9.00am. Pupils will be back in school for approximately 5.30pm – please note, if the bus is late we will update parents via Twitter/text message.
Venue	Children will start at Seahouses and will walk along the beach to Bamburgh.
Packed lunch required?	Packed lunches will be required for all children – please note we are a nut free school. Children will need to carry their packed lunches in a backpack. They will need plenty of fluids.
Clothing to be worn	Children are asked to wear sensible clothing with suitable shoes to walk in. They will need to take a rain coat, sun hat and will need to have sun cream applied before they arrive at school. They may need to bring some sunscreen with them (named) depending on the weather.
Other Information	Children can take buckets and spades to use on the beach – please make sure that any items they bring with them are clearly named.
Cost	The cost for this visit is £10 per pupil (which is the same cost as last year's visit) and £6 for those children eligible for Free School Meals.
Volunteers	If you have filled in the online form to volunteer to take a group and can no longer come on the day, please email school.office@lanchesterep.net to let us know as soon as possible, as this will impact on group sizes.

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Information for Adult Volunteers.

If you have filled in the online form and are volunteering to help on the trip, please be aware that you will be accompanying the children as a responsible adult. The children do not differentiate between teachers and adult helpers on trips; therefore your conduct throughout the day must mirror that of the teaching staff. This includes no smoking in front of the children and no use of mobile phones whilst in charge of a group. The only time the teaching staff may be using their mobile phones is to contact another member of staff for issues around the organisation of the day.

You will be allocated to a class and the class teacher will be asking you to be responsible for a small number of children. However, please note that the class teacher has overall responsibility for all children and they may give you specific instructions for the day. Please follow these directions at all times and ensure that you do not just care for your own child to the detriment of others in your group. The safety of all the children is of paramount importance to us which is why it is necessary to make sure that all adult volunteers understand our expectations of them during the day.
