
Year 6 Autumn Term 1 - Parent Information Gods and Mortals

Discover a fantastical world full of mythical creatures and legendary heroes!


Let's discover a fantastical world of mythical creatures and heroes!

This half term, we'll explore the land of Greece and find out about the geography, culture, climate and the variety of Mediterranean islands that make up the country. We'll learn about Zeus and the other gods who reigned from Mount Olympus and listen to the fascinating stories of powerful gods, terrifying monsters, brave heroes and titans. We will use a range of historical source materials to research daily life in ancient Greece. What was it like to be a Greek citizen in a country that was the birth place of democracy, philosophy, drama and the theatre? Finally, we will consider the legacy of the ancient Greeks – they left the world such an impressive legacy of ideas that many of them were seen for centuries in the civilizations that followed and, even today, cultures around the world continue to display many of the features of life in ancient Greece.
