Dear Parents and Carers,

I have been very proud of all children across the whole school this week. Year 6 have shown great resilience and commitment to doing their absolute best in their statutory tests which is all anyone can ask of them. However, the rest of the children have been very respectful too. Their routine has been slightly different with later playtimes and not being able to use some of our intervention rooms, but they have just taken it in their stride and shown how much they care about their buddies too! Great admiration for the whole school!

We have our third Turing visit taking place next week when staff and Y5 & Y6 children head off to Madrid for 5 days. I know they are going to have an amazing week and will enjoy so many wonderful activities during their time in Madrid, as well as visiting our partner school. This really is such an amazing opportunity for them all – the first flight for some too!

## Walking Bus

We have been overwhelmed with the number of families who would like to use the Walking Bus next week which is wonderful! However, please note, only those who have completed the form can be part of this as we have based our adult: pupil ratios on the numbers who completed the form.

We look forward to meeting families in the Kings Head Car Park ready to leave at 8.25am each morning and again at 3.25pm after school. Please note, this is on Monday, Tuesday and Thursday only due to Wheels Day taking place on Wednesday. We will have our army of staff to meet your little people!

We will have high vis jackets for the children, and will be walking across the green and into school via the field gate. Please make sure your child is there on time and ready to set off from 8.25am as we will need to begin promptly. Also, please remember that your child will need to be walking – they cannot bring scooters/bikes. Watch out for us all heading to and from school and doing our small part to help reduce parking issues around school.

## Monday 20th May 2024 – Turing Trip Departs

The cars will depart at 7am from the Junior Car Park on Monday morning. Please arrive just before 7am.

## Monday 20th May 2024 – Carousel of Activities

The children will be taking part in activities all day. PE kits will be needed for everyone.

## <u>Tuesday 21<sup>st</sup> May 2024 – Forest Schools Day</u>

All children will be spending time in the Forest at some point during the day on Tuesday. Please make sure your child is wearing appropriate footwear and clothing for the day. Obviously this may vary according to the weather conditions!

## Wednesday 22<sup>nd</sup> May 2024 – Wheels Day

All children are asked to bring a wheeled item to school for the day whether it be a bike, scooter, pram, pushchair etc. Please do not send them into school with roller skates, rollerblades or hoverboards as they will not be allowed to use them as these are just too dangerous. For any 'rideable' item, they will need to bring a helmet, as they will not be allowed to use them without one. Nursery children will leave theirs on the Nursery yard and Reception children in front of their wooden fence. Year 1 and 2 children will bring theirs through the field gate and leave theirs on the Infant Yard while Year 3 and 4 children will wheel theirs through and leave theirs on the Junior Yard. Year 5 are to leave their bikes on the MUGA and Year 6 against the wall of the Y3 classrooms past the field gate and down the side of the MUGA.

## Wednesday 22<sup>nd</sup> May 2024 – Jungle Soft Play Bus for Early Years

Early years are looking forward to having The Jungle Soft Play Bus in school on Wednesday. This is a slightly different way for our children to get active, with multiple levels, tunnels and ball pits it provides a safe and

stimulating environment for children to explore, climb, slide, and play. What a great way for our youngest children to safely exert their boundless energy – we cannot wait!

## Wednesday 22<sup>nd</sup> May 2024 – Year 5 Cycle Ride

Year 5 are to leave their bikes on the MUGA so they are easily accessible for their ride. Thank you to those parents and carers who have offered to help and come along on the ride. We are aiming to leave at 9.30am and will return to school no later than 2pm. Please check that bikes are in a good working order over the weekend with well-inflated tyres and brakes that are in good working order.

All adults and children MUST have a helmet, packed lunch and plenty of fluids in a backpack. Any children not going on the bike ride will stay in school and have a 'normal' wheels day.

#### **Early Years News**

Nursery have been busy exploring sunflowers again this week and have shared some wonderful information that they have found out at home. Thank you for support with this. Mrs Davis has been helping everyone to plant a seed to bring home - we look forward to hearing about how they grow. The children are very confident in talking about what they need to do to care for their sunflowers as they grow and will no doubt tell you all about it.

We are really looking forward to Fun & Fitness Week! Please check the weather in the morning for possible temperature and rain changes. Make sure your Reception child has their PE hoodie and raincoat just in case. Nursery children are also welcome to come dressed in their sports gear ready to be active. Please remember that even though children are not in uniform, their clothes still need to be clearly labelled with their name and they will still need their spare bag of clothes in school in case of accidents.

#### **Nursery Opening Times**

Please remember that Nursery doors are open from 8.45am and close at 9.00am. Please make sure you get your child into Nursery on time as we seem to have a large number of children arriving after this time at the moment. This is often very unsettling for those who are late, as they have to be brought through to Nursery past the Reception classes with adults they don't know well. It also means they are missing key parts of the Nursery day. This is especially important for those children moving into Reception in September, who will need to get used to coming into school on time.

## Nursery & Reception Roker Beach Trips

Adult places for the Roker Beach trip are filling up really quickly, so we will be shutting the form on Wednesday 22<sup>nd</sup> May. We will also be shutting the form on Wednesday 22<sup>nd</sup> May for Nursery children, so if you do not fill the form in by then, we will assume your child is not attending the trip, and will book buses accordingly. Please make sure if you haven't filled in the form, you do so by Wednesday 22<sup>nd</sup> May as we will not be able to accept any late bookings.
