Tea Time Club

Applying for a Secondary School Place

Applications for Secondary School places opened on 1st September and close on 31st October. Applying for a Reception Place

Likewise, many parents of Nursery aged children will be visiting schools, ready to start their Primary School Journey next year. If your child was born between 1st September 2020 and the 31st August 2021, you will need to start applying for a primary school place. Applications for Reception places close on 15th January 2025. Please note that even if your child attends our Nursery, you must still apply to the Local Authority for a place in Reception. In the past we have had families miss out on places because they haven't applied, thinking that they will automatically continue into Reception. Key Stage 2 News

Year Group Topics

In class, the children are well into their autumn term topics. Year 3 have travelled back in time to the Stone Age as part of their Tribal Tales topic, whilst Year 4 have been finding out about life across the Atlantic Ocean in 'Road Trip USA.' Our Year 5 children are launching themselves into Space with 'Stargazers' and finally, Year 6 will be learning about the voyage of Charles Darwin and his work on Evolution as they encounter 'Darwin's Delights." Key Stage 2 Class Novels

Each year group has started reading a new novel linked to their topic.

All children in our Key Stage 2 classes use these texts to take part in whole-class shared reading lessons. We teach comprehension skills using the reading domains from the National Curriculum. These are taught to children through our VIPERS approach to reading (vocabulary, infer, predict, explain, retrieve and summarise.)

Why not ask your child about their whole class book and how they are using it to learn about their topics?

Each week, the children will be given a piece of maths and English homework and spellings to learn.
