Dear Parents and Carers,

We are approaching that time of year which is really tough for children and young people everywhere as they approach their exams and tests. Our Year 6 children sit their statutory tests next week which test their ability in Maths and English. I think it is really important for us all to remember that these children are 10 and 11 years old and that these tests only assess a very limited amount of their knowledge.

We are very proud of each and every one of our Year 6 children and know they all possess a wide range of talents between them. Some excel at Maths and English and will perform well in the tests. The talents of others may lie in the football pitch, cricket pitch, netball court, acting, languages or playing a musical instrument. They all perform so well in many different areas which are not being tested but that does not mean that they are not talented because we know they are. Every single one of them. We need to celebrate them all. First and foremost, however, is the fact that they are kind, caring and compassionate individuals who look out for each other. That is the most important talent we prioritise in school. I always tell them at the start of Year 6 that the most important thing to us is that they leave us at the end of the year as good citizens and I am proud to say we are well on target for that to happen!

We will have fun with them next week. Yes – they do have to sit the tests. But we will make sure that they have a party-style breakfast, 'play' with Nursery, Reception and Year 1, enjoy the lovely weather for extended periods outside and finish the week in style with a pizza party and their leavers' hoodies. I hope that, once again, as every Year 6 cohort has said in the past, that next week will be their best week in the school year! Only then will I feel that we have been successful in our jobs.

Year 6 Breakfasts

We would like Year 6 to join us at 8.15am every morning next week to enjoy their special SATs breakfasts. They have put their orders in for what they would like and have a feast of breakfasts waiting for them! They are to come through the Junior Hall Door and head straight down to the Year 6 classrooms at 8.15am. Please do not arrive prior to that as we won't be ready for them! Anyone requiring Breakfast club prior to 8.15am will be taken down to class at 8.15am with the rest of their friends. Thank you.

Walk to School Week and Walking Bus

It is National Walk to School Week during our Fun and Fitness Week – week beginning Monday 20th May and we are hoping to play our small part in encouraging as many children as possible do try to Walk to School. We have an increasing number of children coming to school on cycles or scooters which is also great!

During Fun and Fitness Week, from Monday 20th May to Thursday 23rd May, staff from school will operate a Walking Bus from and to The Kings Head. A Walking Bus is where children walk to school together from a given point.

Staff will meet parents and children in the car park at The Kings Head at 8.25am. We will then walk the children along to school. We will do the same at the end of the school day, leaving school at home time and meeting parents at The Kings Head Car Park at 3.25pm.

On Monday, an online form will be sent out to all parents which we ask you to complete to let us know which day/s you would like your child to be part of the Walking Bus. We can only have children whose parents have completed the form as we have ratios of adults to children that we must follow.

If you have any questions about this, please just ask the School Office or myself. Let's hope this is a success!

Parking and Road Safety

We are never going to solve the problem of parking and the number of cars in the village at key points of the day. However, what we can do, hopefully, is educate people on road safety and how to help keep all of us safe – especially our children.

- Double Yellow Lines are there for a reason. Please follow the law and do not park on them.
- Performing a 3-point turn in the middle of the road at the busiest time of the day is not a good idea.
- Driving onto the path is just dangerous.
- It is not necessary to park as close to school as possible. Please consider using the Social Club or Kings Head Car Parks who are both more than happy for you to park there.

Early Years News

This week in Nursery, we are trying to become Sunflower Experts and find out as much as we can about sunflowers. We have been thinking about what we already know and how to find out more. The children's challenge now is to find out something new about sunflowers to share with us in Nursery. Maybe they could take a trip to the library or they could be supported to use https://www.kiddle.co./ which is a safe visual search engine for children to use. Can they find any pictures of sunflowers or any works of art including sunflowers? They might like to watch this time-lapse video of a sunflower growing from seed, which we are also sharing in Nursery: https://youtu.be/x5mHzwEOpp4 We are really excited about this project and welcome any support from home to keep the enthusiasm going.

In Reception we have begun looking at the life cycles of butterflies and frogs. How funny that their babies look nothing like the adults! It reminds us of one of our favourite stories Monkey Puzzle, by Julia Donaldson, that we have been reading this month. We have been searching the woodland for both caterpillars and tadpoles to observe their changes over time. We hope to soon see butterflies and frogs. *Miss Butler*

Key Stage One News

We have enjoyed another action packed week in Key Stage 1.

Year 1 have been out and about this week with a trip to Dora's Wood. We spotted lots of plants and wildlife and saw the beautiful blossom trees by the river. We have also been exploring shadows in science. Drawing round our shadows in the sun and making shadow puppets with torches.

We are sending phonics words home to practise every week. Please read these with your children to give them practise reading real and nonsense words. Just 5 minutes practise a day will make a massive difference!



Year 2 have been loving their new class book 'The Boy who Grew Dragons' and they have been writing some excellent descriptions of dragons. They have also been experimenting with growing cress in different locations around their classroom to see which will germinate first.
