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Accelerated Reader

Our reading scheme continues much the same as in Year 2. The children take a 'Star Quiz,' where they have text and questions to answer. (currently using levels from end of Y2)

This shows what the children comprehend about the text they have read. This will give them a ZPD range (Zone of Proximal Development).

Children then go to the library and select 2-3 books from their point in the range - one of which will come home.



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Accelerated Reader

Once they have read a book, at school they will take a 'quiz' on the iPad.

(The login details won't go home as needs to be completed in school).

They will get a score and need to aim for 3/3, 4/5 or 8/10.

At the end of each term the children will take another 'Star' quiz to see if the ZPD has changed.

Please ensure that the children have their reading books and records in school everyday to enable them to take the quiz.

Children may will also use Reading Plus and Lexia throughout Y3 as well.



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Spelling

In year 3 we begin using Sounds and syllables for our spellings. This uses what children learned during their phonic sessions in KS1.

Spellings will come home on a weekly basis.
