Dear Parents/Carers,

We will be taking our Year 5 children on an overnight residential to our partner school, Birchwood Primary in Tamworth, Warwickshire, on Thursday 28<sup>th</sup> and Friday 29<sup>th</sup> September 2023. This is going to be a great experience for them all and one which we are all looking forward to. We have organised a visit to The National Space Centre in Leicester as well as a trip to Cadbury World in Birmingham.

The planned itinerary is below for the two days. The cost will be £65 per pupil and £32.50 for those eligible for Free School Meals. The school budget is also subsidising this visit.

The children will need to wear their school jumper for the visits on both days for easy identification. They can wear comfortable trousers and footwear both days. A packed lunch will be provided on the Friday but children **MUST** bring their own packed lunch on Thursday to eat on arrival at Cadbury World.
