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## Accelerated Reader

Our reading scheme continues much the same as in Year 2.

The children have already started by taking a 'Star Quiz,' where they have text and questions to answer.

This shows what the children comprehend about the text they have read. This will give them a ZPD range (Zone of Proximal Development).

Children then go to the library and select 2-3 books from the beginning of the range - one of which will come home.



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## Accelerated Reader

Once they have read a book, at school they will take a 'quiz' on the iPad.

(The login details won't go home as needs to be completed in school).

They will get a score and need to aim for 3/3, 4/5 or 8/10.

At the end of each term the children will take another 'Star' quiz to see if the ZPD has changed.

Please ensure that the children have their reading books and records in school everyday to enable them to take the quiz.

We will continue to use Reading Plus, Lexia and Sounds Write throughout Y3 as well.
