We shall let you know how much we made – money which will go towards purchasing some playground equipment for both Early Years and KS1 and KS2.

Nativities

We are looking forward to seeing you all at our nativities and Carol Service and Christingle next week. It is certainly going to be a very busy but enjoyable week! For the nativities in school, please note that we will not be able to open the doors until around 10 minutes before the performance is due to start. Every morning we need to set the hall up after breakfast club with over 150 chairs to set out and every afternoon, we need to wait until the hall is cleared after dinner time before we can set the chairs up again. Therefore, we will not be able to let anyone in early.

In the past we have made hot drinks for everyone attending the nativities. Unfortunately, this is not going to be possible this year due to the numbers attending and the lack of staff.

Photos and Videos at Nativities

We have a number of children who are not allowed to have photographs or videos taken of them, for many different reasons. Therefore, photographs and videos of any nativities cannot be taken. I am sure you will all understand how crucial it is that we ALL adhere to this.

However, we do understand how important it is to have a photograph of such a key event in your child's life so at the end of the nativities, you will have the opportunity to take photographs of your child on stage. It may take a while to do this, but it has always been appreciated in the past. You might just have to bear with us as it can take some time to get through everyone who wants a photo!
