SEND Information

Durham SEND Information Advice and Support Service (SENDIASS) is a statutory service supporting parents/carers of children with special educational needs and disabilities (SEND) and children and young people with SEND. They provide confidential, impartial support and advice for parents/carers, children and young people up to 25 years old in relation to special educational needs and disability, and operate at 'arm's length' from the council.

SENDIASS runs monthly drop-in sessions in local Family Hubs, which may be helpful if you have questions about your child's educational needs, would like more information or support in relation to SEND or need help with transfer arrangements, or paperwork, regarding the choice of your child's next education setting.
